We are pleased to announce that registration for the rescheduled 2023 ACS Leadership Institute (LI) is now open. Please share this message with your 2023 local section leaders who may be interested in attending the LI. The link to register can be found at the bottom of this message.

Date & Location

The 2023 ACS Leadership Institute will be conducted as an in-person event on January 20-22, 2023, in Atlanta, GA. The LI will commence at 1:30pm of Friday, January 20 and will conclude at 11:30am on Sunday, January 22. (An optional networking lunch will be served at Noon on Friday). Location: Atlanta Marriott Marquis (265 Peachtree Center Avenue, Atlanta, GA 30303).

Registration Fees

The registration fee for one delegate is \$425.00 which covers two nights lodging (Friday and Saturday nights), meals, and conference materials. Local sections are encouraged and may choose to send more than one delegate; however, the registration fee for any additional delegates is \$800.00, which, again, covers lodging, meals, and conference materials.

Should you need to extend your stay to arrive before Friday or depart after Sunday, you, or your local section, will be responsible for the additional costs. Additional room nights are \$280 inclusive of tax and fee for each night. You may request your hotel accommodations when you register for the conference. PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE HOTEL DIRECTLY. ACS staff will handle all room requests based on your registration.

Registration fees will not be collected at the time of registration. Your local section treasurer will be invoiced after the conference for your registration fee and any additional hotel room nights.

Safety Protocol: COVID-19

Safety is a core value of the American Chemical Society and will continue to be our ultimate guide for actions affecting ACS members, staff, meeting attendees, and other stakeholders.
